“Avicenna - Semmelweis Scholarship 2020 - 2021”

*Financial Support for
Talented and Motivated Students*

Introduction

On the occasion of the 25th anniversary of the establishment of Avicenna International College (AIC) and the 250th anniversary of Semmelweis University, AIC offers a full-tuition scholarship to talented and highly motivated international students who plan to continue their studies in any bio-medical field and apply to AMFP (Avicenna Medical Foundation Program) or any NCUK program at AIC. Qualified applicants will be selected by the “Avicenna-Semmelweis Scholarship Committee” and will be informed about the steps to be taken to finalize their registration.

Who Can Apply for Scholarship?

International students who fulfill all the requirements of the application as stated below can apply for “Avicenna - Semmelweis Scholarship”:

1. Students who have completed a national high school degree or IB or A-Level or an American high school degree.
2. Students who have achieved a minimum A or 80% of the total scores to be taken in any type of diploma earned.
3. Students who are fluent in English at the level of B2-C1 or IELTS 6.5. AIC will also test the English competency of applicants.
4. Students who show great interest and strong motivation to study in Hungary. They can continue their studies in the UK or other European countries.
5. Students who hold records of social, community, health and sports activities.

The Application Process

All qualified students who wish to apply for scholarship should carefully follow the following steps:

1. Apply for studies at AMFP or NCUK at AIC. Fill out the Application for Studies and submit it to the Admission Department of AIC. Use the electronic form on the AIC website.
2. Apply for “Avicenna - Semmelweis Scholarship”. Fill out the application form and submit it.
3. Prepare all the required documents and submit them online and hand-in the original as instructed. Documents include all the application documents as well as all your supporting documents for scholarship application. You should also include recommendations and support letters.
4. Continue with the completion of the admission and visa process. You will hear about the decision of the “Avicenna - Semmelweis Scholarship Committee” at this time.
5. Participate in all the online events of AUAP (Avicenna University Admission Process).

Admission and Notification Process

1. You receive the official decision of the “Avicenna - Semmelweis Scholarship Committee” in writing. If you are granted the scholarship, you do not need to pay any tuition fees and you will complete your registration and come to Budapest to start your studies. Remember

that you will need to cover the rest of your expenses or apply for other specific grants or financial aid.

2. If you do not qualify for the “Avicenna - Semmelweis Scholarship”, you still have a chance to apply for “Avicenna Bursary” which may provide you with financial help towards your tuition fee or other expenses related to your studies.
3. Highly qualified students with a top performance during their college study may apply and be eligible for scholarships, grants or other financial help from AIC and partner universities towards their university studies at Semmelweis University and NCUK partner universities or other European universities.

Deadline

AIC accepts applications all around the year. There is no deadline for application. Upon admission and success of the scholarship application, you will be advised about the date your course starts. You will also be instructed about the steps to be taken.
