



# **Avicenna International College**

*AIC Rules and Protocols*

*“Rules about Photography and  
Videography”*

While a student at Avicenna International College, students may participate in events, activities or other situations at the Avicenna International College where college representatives take photographs or video recordings of such participation (“Events”).

Students understand that by registering at Avicenna International College, they fully agree and give permission to Avicenna International College to take and use photographs, video and/or audio (“Recordings”) and use the Recordings subject to the terms and conditions below:

1. AIC students hereby give AIC the permission (a) to take photographs of them and/or to record their name, title, voice, image, and likeness in connection with their participation in College Events; and (b) to use their name, title, voice, image, and likeness in connection with the Recordings for the purposes set forth in paragraph 2.

2. In connection with the grant of permission by AIC students pursuant to paragraph 1 above, students understand that AIC may use the Recordings for the purpose of the College education, marketing, alumni, and fundraising activities in any media to include: magazines, newspapers, trade journals, annual reports, booklets, pamphlets, newsletters, advertisements, and other promotional materials; classroom and online course materials; the College Website and its related social media sites; and posting to the college website as public or private content.

3. AIC has no obligation to pay any student a fee or royalty regarding using the Recordings consistent with paragraph 2 above.

4. Students understand and agree that AIC shall own the Recordings and may edit, duplicate, and distribute the Recordings in perpetuity consistent with paragraph 2 above.

All AIC students are legally bound by this Permission which enters into effect upon application and registration at AIC.

For AIC students under 18 years of age, the parent/guardian will agree to this rule and all other rules and regulations of AIC.
